The Facilitator’s Guide includes a pre-test/post-test, the objectives of the lesson, materials needed, and guided discussions. Suggestions for personalizing activities for the needs of your students are included in each lesson. *Lesson Extenders* are listed at the end of each lesson for use as additional hands-on or computer activities, or as substitutions for the activities listed in the Lesson Plan. Activities that engage all of the senses are included to help meet the needs of all learners, regardless of physical or cognitive abilities.
